Technical Field The present disclosure relates to lens units. 2. Description of Related Art Many lens units include an optical lens holding member, an optical lens set, and a support member. The optical lens holding member holds a lens. The support member supports the optical lens holding member. The optical lens set is disposed in the optical lens holding member and focuses the light into an image. When repairing the optical lens, the optical lens holding member has to be moved relative to the support member along a Z direction perpendicular to the optical axis, so that the optical lens of the optical lens holding member can be pulled out of the optical lens holding member along the Z direction. In order to facilitate the movement of the optical lens holding member relative to the support member along the Z direction, a spring may be arranged between the optical lens holding member and the support member.
